TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY OF BARBADOS - SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

1. Students, aspiring for admissions to Washington University of Barbados (WUB) are required to undergo the process of counselling through Roots Education Bangalore, India. This is the only authorized office for admission.

(A processing fee of 4000\$ (four Thousand Dollars only) will be applicable. Please find the below breakup details)

- Admission Fee: 1000\$ (One Thousand Dollars only) Non Refundable.
 - Consultancy Fee: 2000\$ (Two Thousand Dollars only).
 - Visa Processing Fee, MCI eligibility certificate and Consulate Fees: 1000\$ (One Thousand Dollars only) Non Refundable. An initial payment of 1000\$ (**Non Refundable**) for admission and the processing of the acceptance letter shall be carried by the students.
 - The student shall receive a conditional acceptance letter within 5 working days from the date as mentioned on the admission receipt.
 - On receiving this conditional acceptance letter, the student shall make 50% of the payment of the First Year Tuition Fee as listed in the fee breakup payable to Washington University of Barbados (WUB) within a span of 15 days. The University will provide an official receipt to the parents/student after receiving the fee.
2. Once the softcopy of the acceptance letter reaches the student with the confirmation of his/her medical seat at the University; the student is required to pay 2000\$ as Counselling Fee. At that time the University starts the documentation process, where the students would require to produce documents as listed in the checklist for visa processing and purchase of airline tickets (Purchase price of the ticket is the payable responsibility of the students).
 3. A fee of 1000\$ will be payable by the student for Visa Processing, MCI (Medical Council of India) eligibility certificate and Consulate Fees.
 4. On reaching the University, the students can claim the refund of entire Tuition Fees within a span of 15 days. If the refund is claimed after 15 days and before 30 days, the University shall refund 50% of the paid Tuition Fees. However, any refund claimed after the 30th day shall not be accepted.
 5. It is mandatory for the students to produce their respective original mark sheets and original certificates at the time of admissions and other documents as listed in Washington University of Barbados Checklist. The University has the

right to expel the students and cancel their admissions if found that the students have provided incorrect admission criterion and produced false records. In such case, these students have no right to claim back the tuition fee and have to forgo the admission too.

6. Students are understood to have been well-informed by the WUB admission office- consultants about the University, its location, faculty, infrastructure, its rules and regulations, medium of teaching, curriculum, syllabus, interaction with faculty, transportation facilities, climatic conditions prevailing in the country, food, boarding and lodging availabilities, recognition of the degree of the after successful completion of the course, briefing about Medical Council of India (MCI).
7. The Students may incur other expenses apart from the tuition fee which may include shopping for their personal needs, recreation, entertainment, purchase of books etc.
8. The students are required to maintain their Health Insurance Policy. Washington University of Barbados will not be responsible for their sickness or if they meet with an accident at the University.
9. The University has well-appointed Indian chefs, however; the University will not be responsible for the availability of desired food which is served in the mess/canteen. If a situation arises where any student does not like the food, then the student has to be in a position to be responsible for his/her own food. Cooking in dormitories is prohibited as per rules of the University.
10. The students are supposed to pay their annual fee thirty (30) days before the commencement of the next semester when the fee is due.
11. If a student fails in two or less subjects in any semester, they will be promoted to the next semester at the discretion of the Dean. They will continue in the next semester classes, but they will have to pass the failed subjects during the retake exam.
12. If a student fails in three or more subjects in any semester, they will have to pay tuition fee of \$1000 for retaking the exam.
13. Any legal disputes arising in the process are subjected under the jurisdiction of the Government of Barbados.
